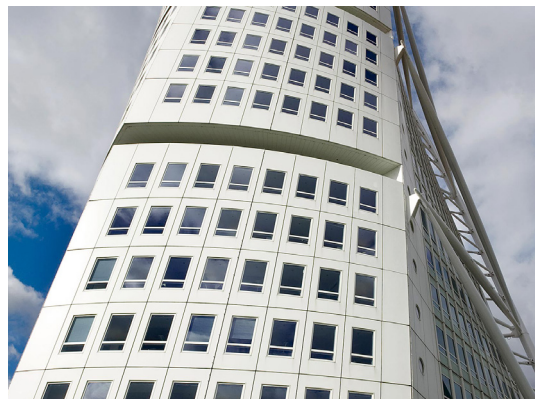

TOUR TRAVEL DETAILS

OHBA has arranged a room block for four nights at the 71 Nyhavn Hotel in Copenhagen and, a one-day private bus trip over the Øresund bridge to Malmö, Sweden. OHBA is not arranging airfare as we anticipate a number of members will prefer to arrive a couple of days early or remain in Europe following the tour. OHBA recommends members book their own flights to arrive in Copenhagen by the afternoon of Sunday, May 12 (at the latest) to join the group for a welcome and orientation dinner Sunday evening. Members should arrange their own departure from Copenhagen anytime on Thursday, May 16.

Please note: Members may wish to arrive a day earlier to get adjusted to the time difference as we have an action-packed tour planned.
